## **Lyu Xin**

**Professor Lyu Xin, Ph. D** of Jiangnan University, postdoctoral fellow of Kyoto University, Japan, is Ph. D tutor, the dean of College of Food Science and Engineering in NWFU. His position includes outstanding regional development talented person of Shaanxi Provincial “Special Support Plan for High-level Talents”, technological innovation leading talents of Xianyang young and middle-aged scientists, member of Shaanxi Provincial Food Safety Expert Committee (and deputy director of Professional Committee of Food Safety Testing Technology) and so on.

He has published 155 papers (82 SCI papers) and applied for 8 national invention patents (7 authorized, 3 industrialized). Professor Lyu serves as an evaluation expert of the National Talent Project, the National Natural Science Foundation of China and so on. He has presided over 1 key project of the China Academic Degrees and Graduate Education Society and 1 key project of the Agriculture and Forestry Working Committee. He has edited 1 textbook for the 13th Five-Year Plan of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs of China, 2 textbooks for the "14th Five-Year Plan" of China Light Industry, and 1 English monograph for Elsevier.



## **ASANALIEV Abdybek Jeksheevich**

Doctor of Agricultural Science and Professor at Kyrgyz National Agrarian University, specializes in Crop Science, Seed Technology, and Plant Breeding. Notable publications include coauthoring "Guidelines on seed technology of the main agricultural crops in the Kyrgyz Republic," "Feed crops of Kyrgyzstan," and a textbook on "Food security and Nutrition."

He served as a part-time Specialist on seed feed crops for a UNDP project from 2013 to 2015 and as an International Agronomist consultant for a FAO project in Tajikistan from 2011 to 2012. As a member of WASWAC (World Association of Soil and Water Conservation), he emphasizes sustainable agricultural practices.



## **Orozov Zhailoobek**

Dr. Orozov Zhailoobek holds a Ph.D. in Biological Sciences and serves as an Associate Professor and the Director of the Kyrgyz Veterinary Research Institute. He is also a part-time instructor at the Department of Infectious and Invasive Diseases within the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Kyrgyz National Agrarian University, named after K.I. Scriabin.

His research involves the development of diagnostic test systems and preventive measures for infectious and invasive diseases. Dr. Zhailoobek conducts studies on the state of veterinary laboratories in terms of biological safety in the Kyrgyz Republic. Additionally, he played a crucial role in the development of the biological safety law of the Kyrgyz Republic. His multifaceted involvement reflects a dedication to advancing veterinary research, enhancing diagnostic capabilities, and contributing to legislative frameworks for biological safety in Kyrgyzstan.



## **Kakimova Zhainagul Khasenovna**

Kakimova Zhainagul Khasenovna is an Honorary Education Worker of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and an Associate Professor at Shakarim University. Graduating in 1990 from the Semipalatinsk Technological Institute, she has been in the education system since 1991. With a Ph.D. obtained in 2003, Kakimova has authored over 300 scientific papers, including monographs, textbooks, and patents.

Acknowledged for her contributions, she received awards and honors from both the city of Semey and the Ministry of Education and Science of Kazakhstan. She currently serves as the scientific secretary of the Dissertation Council at NJSC Shakarim University of Semey and is recognized for her leadership, diligence, and active involvement.
